



TOWN OF CRESTON PROPOSED NEW FIRE HALL REFERENDUM

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VOLUNTEER AS A SCRUTINEER

Public Notice is given to the electors of the Town of Creston to those individuals interested in volunteering as a Scrutineer for the proposed “Protective Services Building Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 1861, 2017”.

The question to be voted on for this proposed Bylaw No. 1861 will be:

“Are you in favour of the Town of Creston adopting “Protective Services Building Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 1861, 2017” authorizing Council to borrow for the development and construction of a new fire hall (\$5,300,000), with the potential inclusion of additional space for the BC Ambulance Service (\$800,000) as long as the BC Ambulance Service will fully pay its share of the debt servicing costs, for a total sum not exceeding six million one hundred thousand dollars (\$6,100,000) repayable over a period of no more than twenty (20) years?”

Only persons entitled to vote as a Resident Elector or a Non-Resident Property Elector within the Town of Creston are entitled to act as Scrutineers. Interested persons may obtain information on the requirements and procedures for making an application by contacting the Chief Election Officer or Deputy Election Officer between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding Statutory Holidays and weekends. Application forms for qualified Volunteer Scrutineers are available for pick up at the Town Hall, 238 – 10th Avenue North.

Completed application forms for qualified Scrutineers **for** the question and completed applications for qualified Scrutineers **against** the question will be accepted from **8:30 a.m. November 7, 2017** (not before) to **4:00 p.m. November 17, 2017** and may be delivered to the Chief Election Officer or Deputy Election Officer at the Town Hall, 238 – 10th Avenue North, Creston, BC, V0B 1G0 or via fax to 250-428-9164 or via e-mail to stacey.hadley@creston.ca or donna.cassel@creston.ca.

If enough applications are received, two Volunteer Scrutineers will be appointed: one (1) Scrutineer for the question (in favour of) and one (1) Scrutineer against the question (opposed to).
