Staff:	<p>PUBLIC HEARING for: Proposed Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 1843, 2016</p> <p>Applicant: Hawk View Estates Ltd.</p> <p>Subject Lands: 718, 724, 730, 736, 742 & 806 Hawk View Drive</p> <p>Purpose: In general terms, if adopted, the new Bylaw would change the zoning of the subject properties from R-1, Single Family Residential to R-3, Multi-Family Residential use. This will allow an increased housing density, permitting the construction of up to a maximum of 21 dwelling units on the subject properties, in the form of clustered housing (pocket neighbourhoods), townhomes, or other similar housing options.</p> <p>Proposed Zoning Bylaw Amendment: The intent of this Bylaw is to amend Schedule "A", being the Zoning Map, by rezoning the properties legally described as Lots 17 - 22, District Lot 9554, Kootenay District, Plan NEP87108 (718, 724, 730, 736, 742 & 806 Hawk View Drive) from "Single Family Residential (R-1) Zone" to "Multi-Family Residential (R-3) Zone".</p>

Chair:

I will now explain the **Public Hearing Procedure**.

We are convening this Public Hearing to consider and receive submissions regarding proposed Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 1843, 2016.

Anyone who believes their interest in property is affected by the proposed Bylaw will be heard, or may make a written submission. No one will be discouraged or prevented from making his or her views heard.

Council members may ask questions of you following your presentation but our function tonight is to listen to the views of the public, not to debate the proposed Bylaw.

After the Public Hearing has concluded, Council may, without further notice, give whatever effect Council believes proper to the representations.

Council has received documents which are available for your review. Please refer to the Public Hearing Binder to review these documents. Written submissions received during the course of these proceedings will be read aloud by staff and subsequently will be added to the Public Hearing Binder.

Your only opportunity to comment on the proposed Bylaw is during the Public Hearing. We are not permitted to receive further submissions once we have closed the Public Hearing.
