► ALLEY BETWEEN 11<sup>TH</sup> AND 12 AVE N - SPEED CONCERNS THAT Ltr #450 from the Manager of Engineering regarding speed concerns along the Alley between 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue North be received as information; THAT Staff consider the installation of portable speed humps if complaints escalate; THAT future monitoring of this location using Traffic Analyzer's be undertaken on occasion to ensure that traffic volumes and/or speeds do not increase to the point of becoming a safety concern; AND FURTHER, THAT no further action be taken at this time as traffic characteristics in this alley do not deviate outside of expected norms.
