Bylaw No. 1857

A bylaw to repeal Commercial Vehicle Licensing Bylaw No. 1335.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Creston has chosen to withdraw from its participation with respect to the licensing of commercial vehicles;

AND WHEREAS the *Local Government Act, Division 2, Section 630* authorizes municipalities by bylaw to participate in the licensing of commercial vehicles, or to repeal an existing bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Creston, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Part 1 Citation

- 1.1 This bylaw may be cited as “Commercial Vehicle Licensing Repeal Bylaw No. 1857, 2017”.

Part 2 Severability

- 2.1 If a portion of this bylaw is held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of this bylaw is deemed to have been adopted without the severed section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or phrase.

Part 3 Previous Bylaw Repeal

- 3.1 Town of Creston Bylaw cited as “Commercial Vehicle Licensing Bylaw No. 1335” is hereby repealed.

READ A FIRST TIME by title and SECOND TIME by content this 19th day of September, 2017.

READ A THIRD TIME by title this 19th day of September, 2017.
