APPLICATION TO VOTE BY MAIL 2022 GENERAL LOCAL ELECTION

Instructions:

1. Complete this form and return to the Chief Election Officer at Town Hall, 238 – 10th Avenue North, Creston, BC, or by email at elections@creston.ca, as soon as possible. This form must be received by the Chief Election Officer, or designate, no later than **4:00 pm on Thursday, October 14, 2022**, to receive a mail ballot.
2. Please note that after **October 6, 2022** all mail ballot packages must be picked up at Town Hall.
3. If your application is complete and you qualify to vote, mail ballot packages will be distributed the week of **September 26, 2022**.
4. You are responsible for ensuring that your completed ballot is received by the Chief Election Officer at Town Hall (238 - 10th Avenue North) **no later than 4:00 pm on Friday, October 14, 2022** (preferred), or at the Upper Rotacrest Hall (230 – 19th Avenue North) on **General Voting Day, Saturday, October 15, 2022, no later than 8:00 pm**.

and request that I receive a ballot to vote by mail, under the provisions of section 110(1) of the *Local Government Act*, for the 2022 General Local Election to be held on Saturday, October 15, 2022.

To be eligible to vote in the 2022 General Local Election, you must be:

- 18 years of age or older on October 15, 2022;
- a Canadian citizen;
- a resident of BC for at least the past 6 months;
- a resident of the Town of Creston;
- if applicable, a non-resident registered owner of real property in the Town of Creston for at least the past 30 days; and,
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election and not otherwise disqualified by law.
