Purpose

This bulletin is to inform staff, owners, retailers, installers and contractors of the regulations for solid fuel burning appliances (SFBA)

Documents Required

- ✓ A floor plan showing where in the home the appliance is to be installed
- ✓ Specification sheets showing this appliance meets Canadian CSA, ULC or WH#
- ✓ Completed Building permit application form
- ✓ Owner's Authorization (Signed by owners on title)
- ✓ Trade Qualification Number or WETT Certification of Installer
- ✓ Confirmation that Smoke/Carbon Monoxide alarms are installed as per BCBC
- ✓ For alterations or renovations to structures built prior to 1990 a Hazardous Material Assessment Report is required. (Contact Worksafe BC @250.426.9789)
- ✓ Confirmation that compromised air/vapor barrier will be made continuous along with fireblocking as per BCBC

This information is provided for your convenience only and it should be clearly understood that you must satisfy all applicable Zoning Regulations and ensure that the premises conforms to the B.C. Building Code and all Bylaws/Regulations of the Town of Creston.
